HOSTING ORGANIZATIONS

- 1) The Urban Kids Academy is a private, bilingual nursery for kids aged 8 weeks to 3 years in Stuttgart near the Kriegsbergturm. Their intercultural team of 10 professionals and students after children in two spacious. The garden offers a protected space for year-round outdoor activities. With a lovingly furnished indoor area, we create an ideal environment for the children development and a place that feels like a second home.
- 2) Haus St. Elisabeth is a day care centre for adults with disabilities. 20 adults are cared for by the centre. The focus is on offering individual support and providing activities that suit the guests' needs. The guests are all adults aged 25 to 80 with different physical and mental disabilities.
- 3) The KBV offers different services for people with disabilities including an assistance service at the municipal Margarethe-Steiff-School for disabled children. The school covers all grade levels. It has a unique support system for its students: 140 employees care for 170 students.
- 4) The Kulturinsel Stuttgart is a diverse meeting place for neighbours, those interested in art and culture, people with and without a refugee background, makers and garden lovers. It harbours a green oasis and a learning garden: the urban gardening project Inselgrün combines the worlds of subculture and industry. It is a platform for social and cultural projects or events of all kinds.

4 MISSIONS

- 1) Support the care of bilingual children (German/English) and work closely with professionals.
- · Playing and learning with the children, creative activities.
- Support the team with housekeeping tasks (preparing breakfast, etc.)
- Participating in training and team events.
- 2) Accompany and support people with disabilities in their daily lives (baking and cooking, etc.)
- · Support residents in leisure activities (playing, music, sports, etc.)
- · Housekeeping tasks
- 3) Support children with physical disabilities in mobility (helping them to go to the bathroom or use their wheelchair)
- · Work together with the special education teacher and a team consisting of physiotherapists, nurses, assistants and accompany the children and young people in a class of 5 to 6 children in their daily school lessons.
- In the Alex Club area, you can choose for yourself whether you want to focus more on the leisure activities during the week, at the weekends, or the leisure activities during school breaks.
- 4) Prepare and support events
- Urban gardening
- Support in administration and documentation

- Monthly allowence for personal expenses and food.

LOCALISATION

Gersheim (Saar: Gärrschemm) is a municipality in the district of Saar-Palatinate in the German state of Saarland.

It is located approximately 20 km southwest of Homburg, the capital of its district, and 25 km east of Saarbrücken, the state capital.













The "Spohns Haus" in Gersheim is the central institution for environmental education in the UNESCO biosphere reserve Bliesgau.

The mission of the institution is education for sustainable development.

The main goal of our educational work is the organization of short-term projects for school groups and youth groups on different environmental themes.

In addition, Spohns Haus serves as a meeting place for school and youth exchanges near the Franco-German border, particularly with young people from Poland, France and Ukraine.





RECEPTION CONDITIONS

Volunteers work 40 hours per week. However, the weekly output depends on the occupation and the different sequences of the project.

Accommodation for volunteers is organized by the institution within the municipality of Gersheim.

Volunteers receive pocket money of €6.00 per day, which is paid monthly.

In addition, the institution organizes participation in a language course in order to improve the level of German.
