- Reloadable Metro cards for all public transport

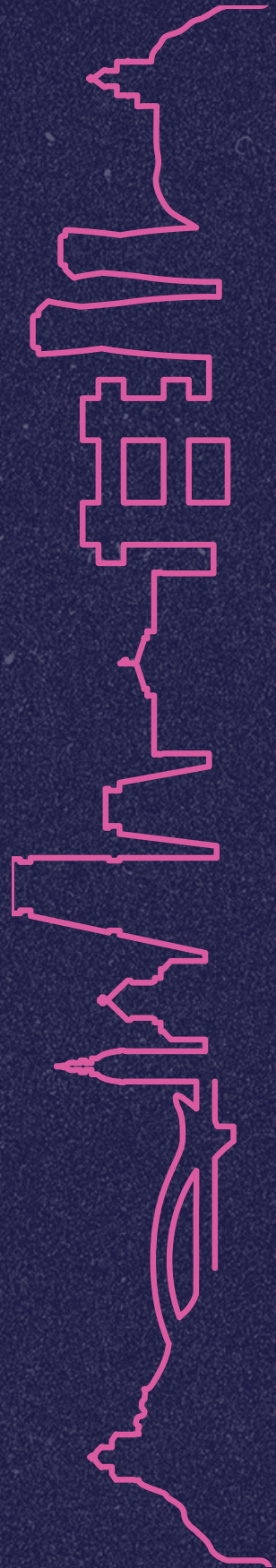
🏠 Accommodation:

🎯 LOCAL WORKSHOPS & SOCIAL EVENTS

Recent sessions we've hosted in Tbilisi:

- "We Are All Human" – A reflective workshop on empathy and community
- "Conflict Resolution" – Non-formal education activities to strengthen dialogue skills
- "Bridge Between Cultures" – Promoting intercultural understanding
- Language Clubs – German-speaking meetups

Volunteer Roles:

- Leading creative sessions, quizzes, reflection circles
- Designing visual materials (posters, social cards)
- Hosting games-lab evenings or language cafés



🎯 DRONI regularly hosts non-formal workshops that spark dialogue, empathy, and awareness around different topics.

👤 Volunteers help create dynamic and inclusive learning spaces where youth can reflect, express and connect.

🚐 EUROBUS- Roadtrip Across the Caucasus

Dynamic mobile project bringing Erasmus+ and ESC to rural Georgia. Volunteers travel with Eurobus team to villages and towns, hosting info booths, icebreakers, team games, quizzes and cultural exchanges.

Volunteer Roles:

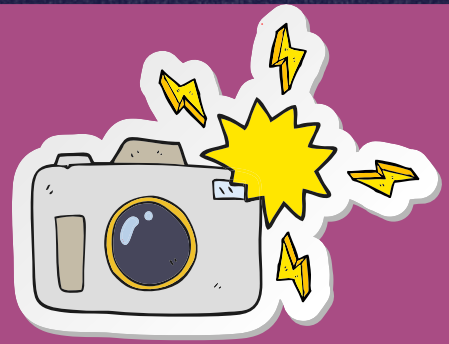
- Co-facilitating workshops and public discussions

Creativity is key to DRONI's youth work. Volunteers help design and lead artistic activities like photography, street art, theater or crafts that use expression as a tool for communication, empowerment and inclusion.

SPECIAL PROJECTS & MENTAL HEALTH INITIATIVES

DRONI integrates well-being into its programming. Examples include wellness days by Lisi Lake featuring yoga and self-care, and the Erasmus+ projects promoting mental health awareness and mindfulness among youth.
