RECEPTION ORGANIZATION

Perekodu Foundation (SA Perekodu) is an institution that provides various services to children and youth with mental or physical disabilities in Viljandi County. Perekodu's regular activities are aimed at providing daily care and counseling, thus contributing to the awareness of children and youth. It is run in cooperation with specialists such as therapists, psychiatrists, social workers and youth police officers. The institution has about 80 employees.

MISSIONS

- The main working complex is the Jaagu kindergarten and school, created for children with special needs. Currently, there are 40 students.
- Children study in groups of 4-6 people, and educators and support staff are there to help them.
- Each student has a personalized program, with an emphasis on developing social and communication skills. A volunteer is expected to be open and willing to learn additional teaching approaches, such as image communication, etc.
- Students also use different methods and playful additions (like robotics) and spend time outdoors.



The centre works in collaboration with the local high school, leisure schools, the library and the cultural centre. Projects are carried out with the Muhu and Tornimäe youth centres. Young people have the opportunity to play billiards, table football, various board games and console games.



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


RECEPTION ORGANIZATION



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

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

Project 1 - Villa Kunterbunt - leisure center for children with disabilities

Start: May 2025 - 30 hours each week

PROJECTS

Place: St.Isidor / A-4060 Leonding

The main tasks in this project are to support the staff and the children in their leisure time activities. The "Villa Kunterbunt" is a place in St.Isidor, where children, who live in the assisted living groups at St.Isidor, can spend parts of their free time.

The children are aged between five and seventeen years. The Volunteer can also possibly organize the "fetch and bring service" of children who can't manage their way on their own.

Volunteers are working on their project in the time from Monday to Friday between 2pm and 8pm. They support with childrens' holidays in the Semester break or the summer holiday camp. Weekends, Easter and Christmas are free, in summer there are fixed holidays for three weeks.

The Volunteer in this project should be sporty and active, musical and creative. The main tasks are e.g. playing football, going swimming doing handcrafts, singing and making music.

Project 2- Assisted living

The main tasks in assisted living are to support the staff in their daily work with doing homework, playing, leisure-time activities, cooking, but also supporting the children and teenagers with their care work. There is one assisted living group, where children live who have several disabilities. They need a lot of special care, therefore this project is perfect for volunteers, who want to gather experience in care work.

There is also a possibility to work in assisted living with young adults, where the tasks are all in all similar to the childrens` groups, this group is in the centre of Linz. Working with young adults means being an example for them, listen to their problems and help them to structure their leisure time.

Volunteers in assisted living are working along a roster which is always set for one month, two weeks before. Every volunteer has five weeks of holidays (if the volunteering is for 12 months) and is free on the public holidays as well. In the assisted living one can take their holidays individually.

We encourage the volunteers to bring their own culture, abilities, ideas and creativity into the group by cooking, singing songs, creating leisure-time activities and so on.





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
